O is for ON TASK

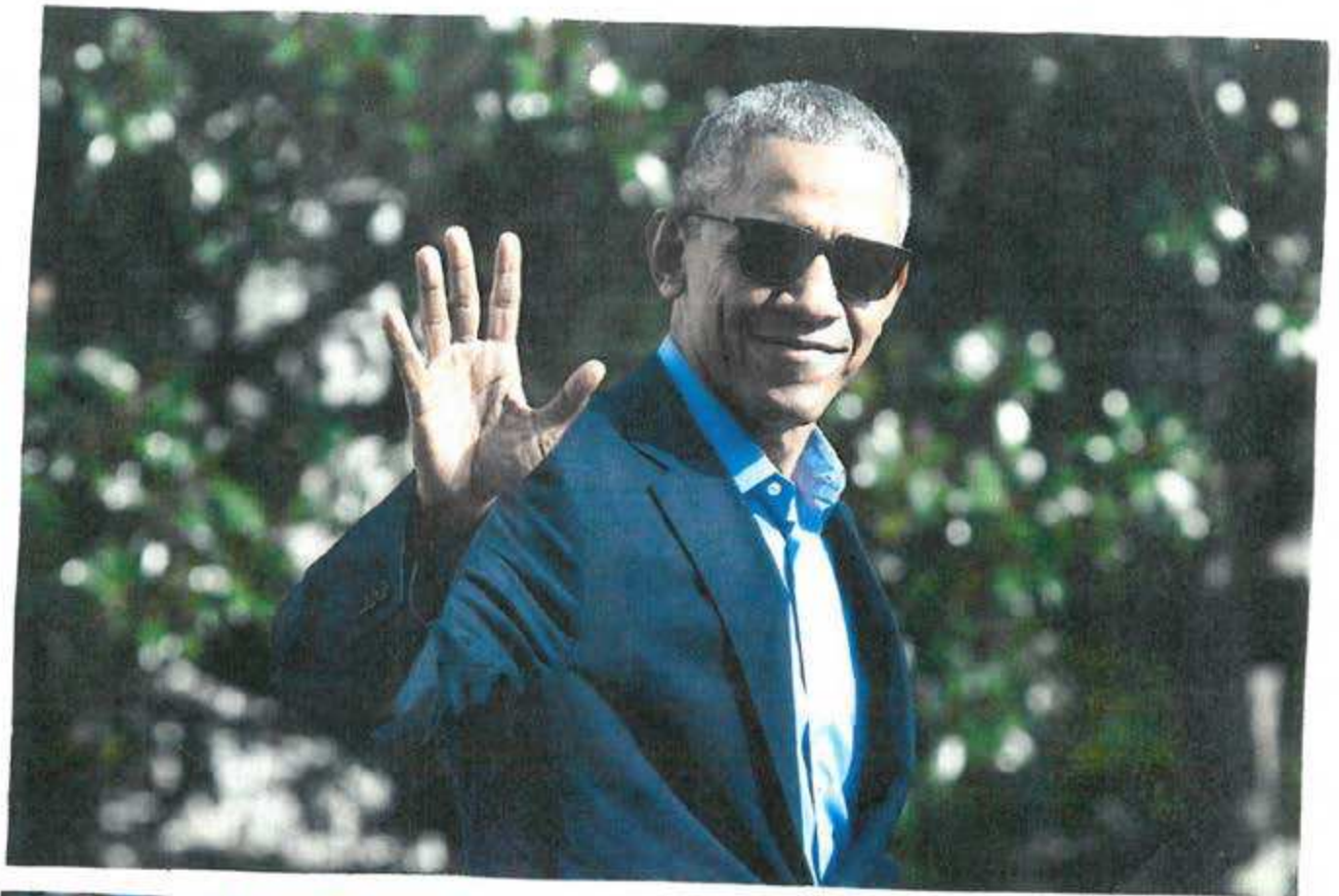
