As part of our important College Prep pillar which is specifically focused on College and Career Readiness, we will be adding an increased focus on ensuring our EXCEL scholars are prepared for the rigor of high school courses, especially in the area of Math.

This summer, EXCEL Academy will be holding a free 6-week Math Boot Camp specifically for 5th grade students. Lead and instructed by our Middle School Math Teacher Mr. Alan Williams, this exciting program will focus on concepts that are geared toward meeting and exceeding both the 5th and 6th grade math standards. Students will be provided instruction that directly connects to the material that they will see next fall. We are excited to present this opportunity for your student to improve their overall math ability and confidence. Math is a skill that has to be practiced and if students have an opportunity to practice the math concepts, we believe they will only improve and be better prepared for the upcoming school year.

The program will begin on Wednesday, June 27, 2018 through August 3, 2018 and will be held Monday through Friday from 8:00am until 1:00pm. Students will receive free breakfast and lunch through the Capital Area Food Bank Summer Meals Program and aftercare will be available for students from dismissal of the Math Boot Camp until 6:00pm daily for a fee.

Having come to the end of another great year, we have seen tremendous growth in our students in both reading and math at Excel Public Charter School. With this concept in mind, we are looking to next year to be even better with our incoming 6th grade students by providing an opportunity for students to advance their math skills in our 6-week program.
